

Material and care instructions for Aintwood

Aintwood – wood-like plastic. A material that resembles wood but can have different textures and colours. It can withstand the sun and rain with a little maintenance. Aintwood should not be used in unventilated, glazed environments where high temperatures may cause the material to soften and distort.

Care instructions

- Rinse/wipe the material with a soft brush, water and a mild detergent, such as soap. Wipe clean with a soft cloth afterwards. Wipe off any stains from strongly coloured liquids, such as coffee and wine.
- Extend the life of your furniture by using a furniture cover, even during the summer, if the furniture will not be used for a prolonged period. NOTE! Do not use dark furniture covers for light Aintwood furniture. There is a risk that the furniture cover may discolour the Aintwood in bright sunlight.
- Never place hot objects directly on the material. This may result in ugly melt marks.
- Drinking glasses can in bright sunlight, for example, act like a magnifying glass, creating a focal point on the table surface, which can lead to burn marks on the table surface.
- Aintwood can be treated with a polishing agent to produce a less sensitive surface. The surface may become slightly darker and shinier after treatment.
- Store the furniture under cover in a dry location or under a furniture cover when not in use. If the furniture is stored exposed, tilt it so that the water easily runs off to prevent water from collecting on it.
